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AGREEMENT TO HOLD HARMLESS, WAIVER AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

*WARNING BY SIGNING THIS FORM YOU GIVE UP IMPORTANT LEGAL RIGHTS, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO SUE, PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!

IN CONSIDERATION OF being permitted to undertake certain activities including but limited to, doggy daycare, boarding (hereinafter referred to as the "Programs". I, the undersigned, for myself, or on behalf of my child or as legal guardian of a minor, personal representatives, heirs and next of kin, acknowledge to and agree with It's A Dog's Life (hereinafter referred to "IADL") and It's The Cat's Meow (hereinafter referred to as "ITCM") that:

1. I am aware that participating in the Programs will include coming into contact with pets that may be difficult to control and may be the cause of injury and I understand the RISK OF INJURY.
2. I am aware of the dangers, risks and hazards associated with my or my child's or my pet's participation in the Programs. These risks include any manner of injury, illness or death including but not limited to PET BITES, SCRATCHES, LACERATIONS, KICKS, INFECTIONS, ALLERGIC REACTIONS AND DISEASE. I acknowledge and agree that I am freely and voluntarily assuming any and all damages, risks and hazards arising there from and further acknowledge that I am entirely at my own risk.

IADL/ITCM and its employees, agents, trustees, directors, officers, their helpers, assistants and each of their respective insurers, heirs, successors, assignees, administrators and executors (collectively, "the Releasee's" are not responsible for any loss, damage, personal injury, death or property damage, however caused, arising from the undersigned participating in or the undersigned's child participating in or the undersigned's pet participating in, the Programs including, without limitation negligence on the part of the Releasee's, breach of contract, occupier's liability or any other tort of cause of action at common law, in equity or by statute.

I hereby release indemnify and save harmless the Releasee's from any and all liability, costs (including without limitation , legal costs), claims, damages, demands, actions and causes of actions at law, by statute and/or in equity arising as a result of any loss, damage, personal injury, death by the undersigned or the undersigned's child or the undersigned's pet as a result directly or indirectly, of the undersigned participating in or the undersigned's child participating in or the undersigned's pet participating in the Programs.

I understand that by signing this document I will be forever precluding from suing or otherwise claiming against the Releasee's for any loss, damage, personal injury, death or property damage that I, my child or my pet may sustain through participation in the Programs. In entering into this agreement, I am not relying upon any oral or written representations or statements made by IADL/ITCM other than what is set for in this agreement.

The foregoing release, waiver, indemnity, and acknowledge of risk is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the laws of the Province of Alberta, and if any portion thereof is held invalid, the balance shall continue in full legal force and effect.

I agree to pay all the charges the day I pick up my pet, and I understand that my pet may not leave the premises until all charges are paid in full. I understand that any animal left for 14 days beyond the estimated date of pick-up will be considered abandoned. It is understood that the undersigned assumes full financial responsibility for all charges incurred. The undersigned remains responsible, however for all charges incurred during the boarding stay even for abandoned pets.

Veterinarian expenses incurred by IADL/ITCM for pets participating in the programs will be charged back to the owner. If we are unable to reach or contact yourself or your emergency contact, and we deem it necessary your pet be attended to by a veterinarian, you accept full responsibility for any related charges and authorize the use of your credit card as provided for this purpose.

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IT'S A DOG'S LIFE BOARDING INFORMATION

DROP OFF & PICK UP TIMES: These are suggested times to allow your pet to socialize and exercise before bed time. Keep in mind you are always charged for the day you drop-off regardless of the time.

Monday to Friday: 6:30am – 4:00pm
Saturday: 8:00am – 4:00pm
Sunday & Statutory Holidays: 8:00am – 3:00pm

Please keep in mind that you are still welcome to drop-off your pet anytime during our regular business hours, these are just suggested times.

You are welcome to pick-up your pet anytime during business hours. If your pet is picked-up before 12:00pm (noon) you will not be charged for the final day. If your pet is picked-up after 12:00pm we charge a hourly rate of \$3.00/dog/hour for day care.

WHAT TO BRING:

Food: We do not encourage disrupting your dog's diet; therefore it is recommended that their own food be supplied during their stay. Please label your air tight container or pre-packaged bag with your dog's name and feeding instructions. It's always a good idea to bring more food than needed. Dogs are typically more active here than at home, so sometimes we may adjust their food if needed. If you do not bring food, we will supply it for an additional charge of \$1.00 per cup (regular) - \$1.50 per cup (premium). *Freezers & fridges available if your pet is on a raw/frozen diet.

Treats: We welcome you to bring along easily chewable treats such as Dentasticks, milk bones, etc.

Medications: All medications should be clearly labelled with your pet's name and dosage requirements. Please note there is an additional charge for administering medications. Pill/liquid form medications are \$2.00 per administration and injections are \$3.00 per administration.

Vaccination Records: Please bring/fax/email your pet's up-to-date vaccination records. Required vaccines are Rabies and the Distemper Combo. Alternatively, we do accept yearly titre test results. Please note that vaccines should be given 7-10 days prior to your visit to be effective. *Bordetella is optional, but we recommend researching the vaccine yourself and/or discussing whether it is necessary with your vet.

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

Toys/Dishes: Please do not bring toys or dishes. We supply toys for our guests during the day and use our own dishes because they need to be sanitized daily.

Bones: As these can sometimes create a choking hazard please refrain from bringing.

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Bedding: We want your dog to feel comfy and cozy when they settle in for the night. We provide Kuranda cot beds, which are off the floor, to all of our guests so there is no need to bring bedding from home. We ensure all guests are comfortable and have a cot appropriate for their size.

PAYMENT: We accept Cash, Debit, Visa, MasterCard and AMEX.
Payment must be made in full prior to your pets departure from our facility.

WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN YOUR DOG RETURNS HOME AFTER BOARDING

Your pet will undoubtedly be happy to see you after your time apart.

Following these few simple steps will help ease the transition back to home life and your pet's normal routine.

- Overexcitement may make a pet pant a lot and act thirsty. He/She is probably not really thirsty as they had plenty of water at the facility. Give him/her a few ice cubes to tide him/her over until he/she settles down.
- Be aware that excessive drinking and eating may lead to digestive upsets and bloating. Do not feed your pet for at least three hours after coming home from the pet care facility. Again, food and water should be limited until he/she has settled back into home life.
- Walk your pet upon arrival or allow them access to a yard area. Excitement may also cause a change in urination or bowel movements outside his/her normal schedule.
- Give your pet some personalized attention such as playtime, petting, or brushing. This will help him/her to get through the excitement stage and calm down.
- A chew toy with treats, such as a frozen Kong with peanut butter, will keep your pet busy and allow them to slowly calm down in their own environment. It's a good idea to have these treats ready for when your pet arrives home.
- A stay at a pet care facility can be very exciting. Some dogs love to bark while having a wonderful time. These dogs often leave the facility exhausted but happy and will sleep a lot for the first couple of days they are home.
- Re-establish home patterns by following a normal schedule. Pets love following a schedule as it makes them feel safe and secure.

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IT'S THE CAT'S MEOW BOARDING INFORMATION

DROP OFF & PICK UP TIMES: These are suggested times to allow your pet to socialize and exercise before bed time. Keep in mind you are always charged for the day you drop-off regardless of the time.

Please keep in mind that you are still welcome to drop-off your pet anytime during our regular business hours. These are just suggested times.

You are welcome to pick-up your pet anytime during business hours. If your pet is picked-up before 12:00pm (noon) you will not be charged for the final day. If your pet is picked-up after 12:00pm we charge a hourly rate of \$3.00/cat/hour for day care.

WHAT TO BRING:

Food: We do not encourage disrupting your cat's diet. Therefore it is recommended that their own food be supplied during their stay. Please label your air tight container or pre-packaged bag with your cat's name and feeding instructions. It's always a good idea to bring more food than needed. If your cat runs out of supplied food during their stay we will purchase the same food, which will be charged back to you (cost of food plus pick-up & delivery charge) *Freezers and fridges are available if your pet is on a raw/frozen diet.

Treats: We welcome you to bring along your cat's favorite treats.

Medications: All medications should be clearly labelled with your pet's name and dosage requirements. Please note there is an additional charge for administering medications. Pill/liquid form medications are \$2.00 per administration and injections are \$3.00 per administration.

Bedding: We encourage you to bring a blanket or something familiar from home for your cat to cuddle up too.

Vaccination Records: Please bring/fax/email your pet's up-to-date vaccination records. Required vaccines are Rabies and the FVRCP (Feline Viral Rhinotracheitis). Alternatively, we do accept yearly titre test results. Please note that vaccines should be given 7-10 days prior to your visit to be effective.

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

Dishes: For health and safety purposes we use our own dishes.

PAYMENT: We accept Cash, Debit, Visa, MasterCard and AMEX.
Payment must be made in full prior to your pets departure from our facility.



WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN YOUR CAT RETURNS HOME AFTER BOARDING

Your cat will undoubtedly be happy to see you after your time apart.

Following these few simple steps will help ease the transition back to home life and your cat's normal routine.

- Overexcitement may make a cat pant a lot and act thirsty. He/She is probably not thirsty as they had plenty of water at the facility.
- Be aware that excessive drinking and eating may lead to digestive upsets and bloating. Do not feed your cat for at least three hours after coming home from the pet care facility. Again, food and water should be limited until he/she has settled back into home life.
- Excitement may also cause a change in urination or bowel movements outside his/her normal schedule. Ensure they have a clean litter box upon arrival home.
- Give your cat some personalized attention such as playtime, petting, or brushing. This will help him/her to get through the excitement stage and calm down.
- A stay at a pet care facility can be very exciting and scary. Cats often leave the facility exhausted but happy and will sleep a lot for the first couple of days they are home.
- Re-establish home patterns by following a normal schedule. Cats love following a schedule as it makes them feel safe and secure.
- After you pick kitty up from the pet care facility, be sure to keep him/her in the house for a few days before allowing him/her to go outside. Just as he/she had to adjust to the pet care facility, they will have to adjust to being home again. Allow him/her to find that "at home" feeling again before letting him/her out of the house.
